

**Village of Bonney
City Council Regular Meeting Minutes
June 20, 2011**

Minutes of Regular City Council Meeting of the Village of Bonney held at the Village of Bonney City Hall located at 19025 FM 521, Bonney, Texas 77583. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Raymond Cantu at 7:00 P.M.

Item 1) Regular Meeting Roll Call:

There was a quorum with the following members present: Alderman Tony Gonzalez, Alderman Bevelria Doyle, and Alderman Terri Velasquez; Mayor Raymond Cantu presided. Alderman Manuel Cantu and Alderman Jennifer Winans were absent.

Item 2) Minutes of May 16, 2011 Regular Council Meeting:

Minutes of May 16, 2011 Regular Council Meeting were reviewed. Alderman Tony Gonzalez made a motion to approve the May 16, 2011 Minutes as presented and motion was seconded by Alderman Terri Velasquez.

Item 3) Matters relating to Treasury Report:

The Treasury Report was presented and bank balances were reported as follows:

Mayor Cantu reported purchase of new computer, monitor, keyboard and software earlier in June and installation of new tile in office.

Item 4) Matters relating to Website Creation:

Mayor Cantu announced Village of Bonney Website is now up and running at Bonneytexas.gov. He gave a demonstration showing main features and related links. He suggested the City prepare a manual newsletter mail-out regarding Bonney's new website.

Item 5) Matters relating to Senate Bill 100:

Mayor Cantu announced Governor Rick Perry had signed Senate Bill 100 changing election dates and that Brazoria County would no longer be able to hold City elections in even numbered years as the bill delays the Primary Runoff until the 4th Tuesday in May. He explained that Brazoria County does not have the equipment or personnel to conduct both Primary Election and City Elections at the same time.

He announced Brazoria County is proposing cities change terms of elected officials to 4 years and holding elections only every other year. This change can be made by a resolution by Village of Bonney and an election would need to be held to change the terms. Brazoria County is offering to hold our election at no charge and would be included at the end of the ballot in November 2011.

There were no visitors or public comments.


