

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1-2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BONNEY, TEXAS CALLING FOR THE ANNUAL GENERAL ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR SAID VILLAGE FOR STAGGERED TERMS AS AUTHORIZED BY THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE; PROVIDING FOR A MUNICIPAL ELECTION PRECINCT AND DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACE THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR APPLICATION FOR CANDIDATES AND SPECIFYING A FILING DEADLINE AND THE DATE WHEN FILING MAY BEGIN; PROVIDING FOR THE QUALIFICATIONS OF ELECTORS; APPOINTING THE OFFICERS OF SAID ELECTION AND DESIGNATING THE NUMBER OF CLERKS; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; PROVIDING FOR RATIFICATION AND CONFIRMATION BY THE MAYOR OF SAID VILLAGE OF THE ACTION TAKEN BY THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE VILLAGE OF BONNEY, TEXAS, DULY ASSEMBLED:

SECTION ONE - Annual General Election Called.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Bonney, Texas, hereby order and ordain, respectively, that a certain annual election for staggered, two year terms of office for the Mayor and Board of Aldermen as authorized by the Texas Local Government Code shall be held in and throughout the Village of Bonney, Texas, on the second Saturday in May, 2012, being the 12th day of May, 2012, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of electing persons to the following named offices of the Village for the following terms of office: Alderman Position 3, two year term; Alderman Position 4, two year term and Alderman Position 5, two year term.

SECTION TWO - Municipal Election precinct and Polling Place.

For the purpose of the general election called and ordained by this ordinance, the entire Village of Bonney, Texas, shall constitute one (1) municipal election precinct and the polling place thereof shall be the Bonney City Hall, located at 19025 Hwy 521, within the corporate limits of said Village.

SECTION THREE - Application for Candidates and Dates for Filing.

For the purpose of the general election called and ordained by this ordinance, the Village of Bonney, Texas shall provide interested persons the opportunity to file for a position on the ballot beginning February 4, 2012 through March 5, 2012 as established by the Election Code. The City Secretary shall conduct mandatory office hours of at least three (3) regular office hours beginning on February 4, 2012 through March 5, 2012. The location for office hours shall be at 19025 Hwy 521 in Bonney, Texas.

SECTION FOUR - Electors.

Every person eligible to vote under the provision of Chapter 11 of Title 2 of the Texas Election Code who is a resident of the Village of Bonney, Texas, and who is duly registered to vote in the precinct where he or she votes shall be entitled to vote at said election.

SECTION FIVE - Officers of Election and Compensation Thereof.

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Bonney, Texas, hereby appoint an early voting ballot board consisting of City Secretary, who shall be the presiding judge of said board, and one (1) election clerk who shall be appointed by the presiding judge of said board in the same manner as provided above for the appointment of the election officers for the regular polling place. The early voting ballot board shall possess the same qualifications, be subject to the same laws and penalties, and be paid the same way as the regular election officials; provided, however, that each member of such board may be paid an amount not to exceed the compensation payable for ten (10) hours of work if the time spent by the board performing its duties is less than ten (10) hours.

SECTION SIX - EARLY VOTING

The Secretary of the Village of Bonney, Texas, is hereby authorized to conduct early voting by personal appearance beginning on the 12th day before election day and ending on the 4th day preceding the day hereinabove specified for said Election, being April 30, 2012, respectively, said early voting by personal appearance to be conducted at the location of 19025 Hwy 521, Bonney, Texas, within the incorporated limits of said City, for at least three (3) regular office hours daily on every day except Saturday, Sunday, and State legal holidays. Early voting by mail shall be as provided by applicable law.

SECTION SEVEN - Method of Voting and Conducting Election.

All early voting by personal appearance and all voting on the day named above for the holding of said general annual election shall be by means of whatever type of voting machine or electronic voting system is available from the voting machine department of Brazoria County, Texas. The manner of holding said election will be governed by the laws of the State of Texas governing general elections and as provided in this ordinance. The Secretary of the Village of Bonney, Texas, is hereby authorized and directed to produce the necessary supplies for said election, to make arrangements with the voting machine department of Brazoria County, Texas, and is further authorized and directed to do and perform any and all other acts required by the Texas Election Code of City Secretaries conducting municipal elections and to do and perform any and all other acts required by all applicable laws.

SECTION EIGHT - Notice of Election.

The Mayor of the Village of Bonney, Texas, is hereby authorized and directed to issue a notice of said election, to cause the same to be posted for at least thirty (30) days prior to the date named above for the holding of said general annual election on the bulletin board used for posting notices of meetings of the Board of Aldermen not later than ten (10) nor earlier than thirty (30) days before the date named above for the holding of said general annual election.


SECTION NINE - Ratification and Confirmation by Mayor.

SECTION TEN - Effective Date.


This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.


