

ORDINANCE NUMBER 3-2023

ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF BONNEY TO CANCEL THE GENERAL ELECTION SET FOR MAY 6, 2023, FOR THE ELECTION OF CITY MAYOR, CITY ALDERPERSON POSITION 1 AND CITY ALDERPERSON POSITION 2, PURSUANT TO THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE, CHAPTER 2, SUBCHAPTER C, SECTION 2.052 ET SEQ., ALLOWING FOR THE CANCELLATION OF UNOPPOSED ELECTION OF MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bonney previously set by ordinance the election of City Mayor, City Alderperson Position 1 and City Alderperson Position 2 to be conducted on May 6, 2023, and;

WHEREAS, the Village of Bonney has received certification that each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed, and;

WHEREAS, there is no proposition to appear on the ballot, and

WHEREAS, no candidate's name is to be placed on a list of write-in candidates for any office on the ballot under applicable law, and;

WHEREAS, the Texas Election Code, Chapter 2, Subchapter C, Section 2.051 et sec. provides that the governing body of the Village of Bonney by order or ordinance may declare each unopposed candidate elected to the office, and;

WHEREAS, this ordinance will fill all positions which are to be filled by May 6, 2023.

THEREFORE,

It is ordered, that Raymond Cantu is elected to City Mayor, and;

It is ordered that Tony Gonzalez is elected to City Alderperson, Position 1, and;


It is ordered that Karen Doyle is elected to City Alderperson, Position 2, and;

It is ordered that the election scheduled for May 6, 2023, shall not be held, and;

It is ordered that a copy of this ordinance shall be posted on election day at each polling place that would have been used in the election.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
